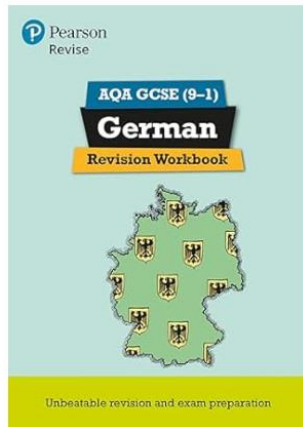
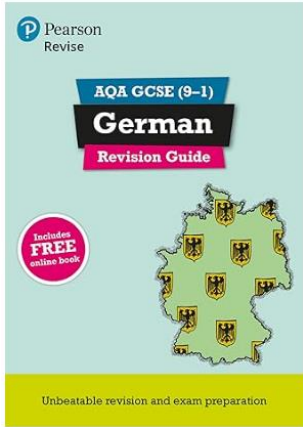
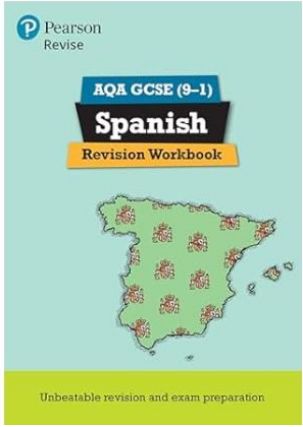
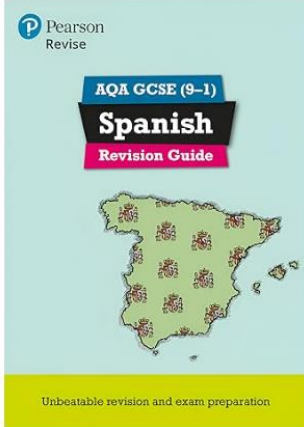
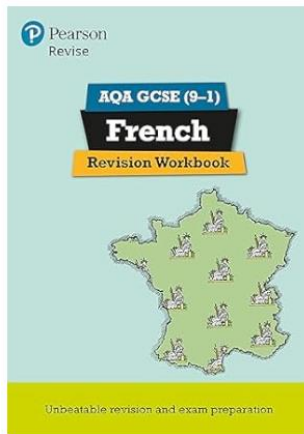
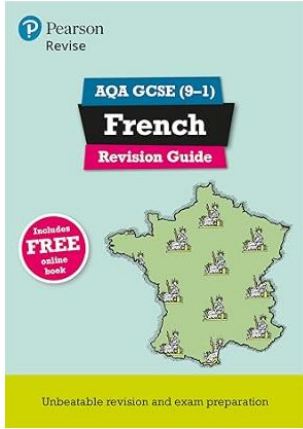
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Specific revision and exam technique

- Students need to practise all four skills as part of their revision (Listening / Speaking / Reading and Writing)
- They need to include past, present and future tenses and at least 3 justified opinions in each piece of written work
- The translation into the target language is a glorified grammar test and requires specific knowledge of core language
- Knowledge of extended language and idioms is important for students aiming for grades 7/8/9

Top tips for students

- Revise little and often
- Complete past papers
- Re-attempt past papers
- Learn phrases you can re-cycle in a range of different contexts
- The more vocabulary you know the better your understanding will be for listening and reading and the better you will be able to write and speak
- Use your cultural knowledge to help with the context of the text you are asked to analyse

As a parent/carer how can I help?

- Test vocabulary
- Practise questions for the speaking exam with your child (even if you ask the question in English and the response is in the target language)
- Encourage your child to teach you words / phrases in the target language
- Watch films / listen to music in the target language
